## **Army Family Action Plan**

AFAP is a grassroots process that encourages Soldiers, retirees, DOD civilians and Family members to say what works and what does not work and what they think will fix it.

## **Army Family Team Building**

AFTB is a program designed to empower Soldiers, DOD civilians and Family members through trainings that enhance their knowledge of Army life and provides them with the opportunity to polish their personal and professional development skills.
