

RESERVATION INFORMATION & SERVICES
BULL POND
2012

Bull Pond reservations will be entertained again for this summer through a lottery system on Saturday, 7 April 2012, at Bonneville Cabin at Round Pond for Active Duty Military Personnel and Cadets ONLY. Proof of Military ID is required at the lottery. Pre-lottery numbers may be obtained beginning 21 March by calling 938-2503, 0800-1800 or at the lottery itself. Lottery is limited to one (1) chance per household (one number-one pick). Spouse/sponsor unable to attend the drawing may send a representative with a signed proxy. Limit one letter per proxy. Numbers are drawn at random until all available dates are reserved or all lottery numbers are drawn. Lottery winners may reserve a single cottage or the entire complex (both cottages) at the rates listed below plus an additional \$40. In addition, one or both cottages will be available only for the entire week of Graduation (Mon, 21 May through Mon, 28 May) and July 4th week (Fri, 29 June through Fri, 6 July) at the rates listed below. Any dates available after the lottery will be opened up to all other eligible personnel on Mon, 9 April at 0800 on a first come-first serve basis. *All reservations require a 100% deposit.* Cash, check or credit cards are accepted.

a. Please contact the Outdoor Recreation (ODR) office at Round Pond, 845-938-2503, at least two weeks prior to your reservation dates so we can confirm check-in time, finalize any details and ensure you can check in directly at Bull Pond. In the event you are unable to stay at Bull Pond during your reservation dates, please notify ODR as soon as possible so we may assist you in securing a replacement. Please note, refunds are not granted for cancelled reservations at Bull Pond.

b. Check in is 2:00 pm and check out is 10:00 am for both Monday and Friday reservations. If you are unable to arrive at Bull Pond by 2:00 pm or need to depart earlier, please contact ODR ahead of time so we can assist you. An ODR staff member will meet you during

your arrival and departure to issue and accept keys and to answer any questions you may have about the facilities at Bull Pond.

c. Bull Pond is a secluded area. We encourage you to keep the entrance gate and facilities locked when not in the complex. ODR assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen property.

d. The Superintendent's Cottage, aka Stone House, has sleeping accommodations for four persons. One king size bed and a double pull-out couch, all fitted with sheets, pillows/pillow cases and blankets, closet and dresser; full bath with tub/shower, and sufficient bath/hand towels and bath mats to sustain your visit; living room with one couch, love seat, and chair, satellite TV/DVD, telephone (845-938-4224); a full service kitchen with table with benches, full sized refrigerator, gas range, microwave, toaster, sink, dishes, glassware, pots and pans, mixing bowls, mixer/blender, coffee pot, (coffee filters are provided), wine glasses, corkscrew, ice trays, BBQ utensils, salt/pepper, water pitchers, dish towels and utensils to accommodate six persons. Also provided is a mop, broom, vacuum cleaner, and appropriate cleaning supplies. A front porch is screened and equipped with lounge chairs. The Stone House is heated but NOT air conditioned. Each room is equipped with a ceiling paddle fan. The fireplace is not operational and is off limits for use. No washer, dryer or laundry facilities are on site.

e. The Guest House accommodates five persons, three single and one double bed, all fitted with sheets, pillows/pillow cases and blankets, dressers; a full bath with shower with bath/hand towels and bath mats; living room with two couches and satellite TV/DVD, full service kitchen with table and chairs for six persons, telephone (845-938-3234), full sized refrigerator, gas range, microwave, toaster, sink, dishes, glassware, pots and pans, mixing bowls, blender/mixer, coffee pot (coffee filters are provided), wine glasses, corkscrew, ice trays, BBQ utensils, salt/pepper, water pitchers, dish towels, and utensils to accommodate six persons. Also provided is a mop, broom, vacuum cleaner, and appropriate cleaning supplies. The Guest House is heated but NOT air conditioned. It also does not have a porch.

f. The Boat House is equipped with marine life vests, paddles, oars, volleyball and horseshoes as well as a billiard table, balls and cue sticks and an outdoor phone (845-938-3234). On the covered porch of the boat house deck, a wooden swing awaits your evenings to view the setting sun on Bull Pond.

g. The waterfront area includes your own private sandy beach, dock and floating raft, a canoe, rowboat and paddleboat with oars, paddles and life vests, plus picnic tables, grills, volleyball and horseshoe pits. Swimming in at the camper's own risk, no lifeguard is available. Boaters are to WEAR life jackets at all times. Fishing is encouraged: anglers 16-adult must have a current New York State fishing license and West Point permit (available at Round Pond). All fish kept are to be recorded in the "Reporting Box" located at the entrance gate to the Bull Pond complex. Bait, tackle, firewood, and supplies are available for purchase at the Round Pond Camping and Recreation Area camp store, Route 293, 845-938-2503. To ensure the safety of our patrons, open ground fires are permitted ONLY in the fire rings provided. Fires in outdoor grills will be only with charcoal.

h. A screen enclosed gazebo located between the two cottages, is equipped with ceiling lights/paddle fan, a wooden Adirondack type settee, and chairs and a table for gatherings of the two cottages.

i. It is appreciated if cottage and gazebo furniture, equipment and bedding are not used outdoors.

j. An outdoor shower is located behind the gazebo for your convenience after leaving the beach to minimize sand from being carried into the cottages.

k. We appreciate users to police the cottages and grounds upon checkout to include swept floors, vacuumed carpets, outdoor game equipment returned to the boat house and all garbage placed in the outdoor dumpster in full garbage bags provided. Cookware, dishes, and utensils are to be washed and put away. Bed linens and used towels should be placed in the laundry basket provided. No maid or room service is provided during your stay.

l. Campers at Bull Pond will be held accountable for any damages and will be replaced or repaired the camper's expense.

m. Pets, any type of weapon, fire arm or fireworks are prohibited. Violators will forfeit their remaining reservation if discovered during staff spot checks.

n. Items we recommend you bring with you are: charcoal, sun screen, bug repellent, radio/music, board games, beach toys, any medications, food and beverages, your favorite beach chair and beach towel and a good book!

o. **EMERGENCIES**, facility repairs, problems and service, occupants are to contact Round Pond, 845-938-2503 or the Military Police, 845-938-3333.

p. Cottage phone numbers: Stone House 845-938-4224, Guest House 845-938-3234. Both numbers require a user access PIN# for out-of-area calls; 446-xxxx and 1-800 numbers do not require a PIN code. There is no internet access and cell phone/blackberry reception is limited. Thank you again for including FMWR in your summer fun!
