## SUBMISSION DATES

### Deployed Families - March 8-12

Families who are not currently utilizing the SAS program and have a spouse deployed. Applications will be taken at Building 1207, Outreach Services, 938-4458.

### Prior DoD Civilian Summer Camp Patrons - March 22-24

Children who have previously enrolled in summer camp. This includes prior full day patrons of the CDC. Applications will be taken March 22 at 7am in Building 1207.

### Open Registration

#### - March 25-26

Open registration for patrons who have not utilized the Summer Camp program or did not attend a CYSS program in 2009. Applications will be taken at Building 1207.

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

Applicants will be notified in early April of the weeks that have been allocated for your child. A registration date and time will subsequently be scheduled with each parent. At the time of registration, parents will be required to pay a 50% deposit for each camp week your child is enrolled. The remainder of the summer camp fees are due to be paid prior to summer camp beginning, NLT May 28. If payment is not made in full by May 28, summer camp will be denied with no refund.

## ELIGIBILITY

Active Duty Military, regularly scheduled DOD civilians and reservists on active duty status, and children who have just completed grades K through 5.

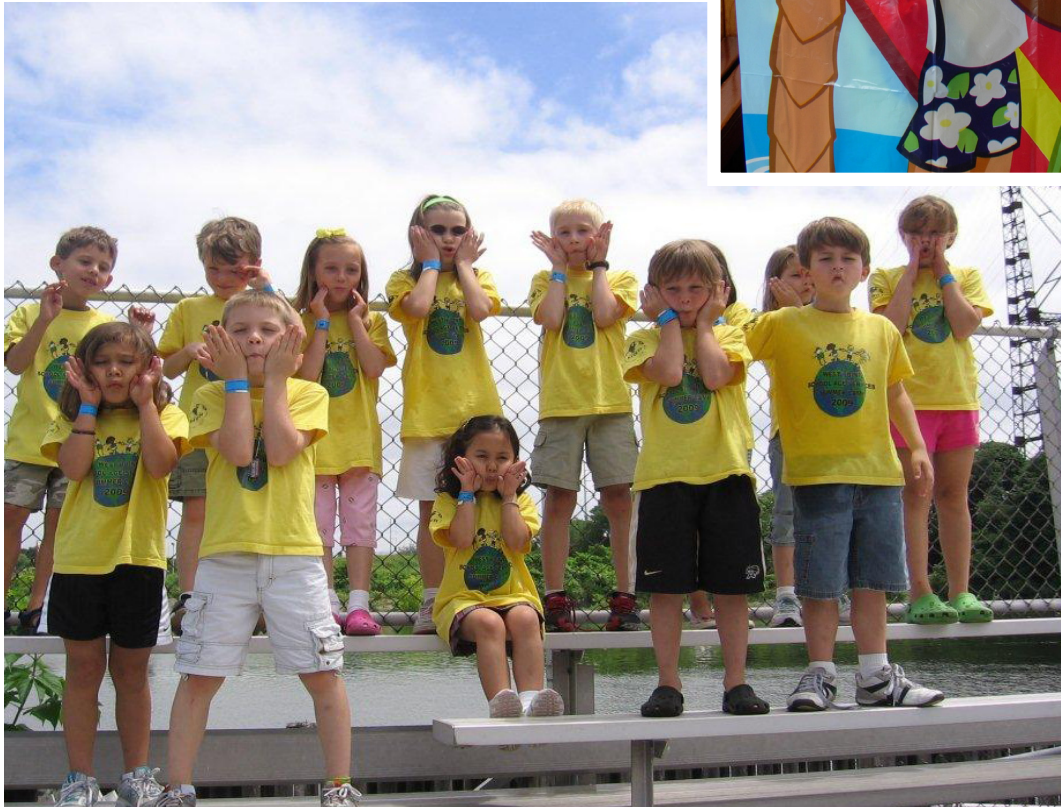

## MEDICATION POLICY / SPECIAL NEEDS ACCOMMODATION

- Administration of medication is to be coordinated with the parent, Child, Youth & School Services (CYSS) staff and CYSS nurse prior to the beginning of camp. Only approved medications will be administered by staff in accordance with the CYSS Health Standing Operating Procedures (SOP) and proper paperwork must be completed (DA 6225).
- Exception to policy requests for other medications must be submitted to the CYSS nurse prior to the start of the program and will be reviewed by the Special Needs Accommodation Process (SNAP) team.
- Children are not authorized to carry their own medications at anytime. Children requiring asthma and/or Epi-Pen medications must have a care plan completed by the child's physician to keep at Building 693 or to take on field trips with staff. Parents must meet with CYSS staff and CYSS nurse in May to review the care plan.
- Children with special needs are reviewed by the SNAP Committee to determine if needs of child can be accommodated in the SAS summer camp program.

## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES OPEN TO TEENS

There will be 15-20 teens needed as volunteer camp counselors. Teens must be at least 13 years old and have completed the eighth grade. Potential counselors must complete an application, due by April 20, and attend mandatory training in May. Potential counselors must commit to a minimum of two weeks per summer.
