

Youth Center Code of Conduct

1. The Youth center is open to unmarried family members of active duty or retired military, grades 6-12, during the times designated.
2. All Participants must sign in upon entering the Youth Center and must present a valid military ID or Youth Center card upon request by the Youth Center staff.
3. All Participants are required to enter and exit through the main door.
4. Participants may use pay telephones. Office phones are for emergency use with staff assistance.
5. For safety reasons, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters and bikes will remain outside and parked in designated areas only.
6. Possession, consumption, or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol is illegal and will be dealt with according to USMA procedures.
7. Smoking and the use of tobacco in any form in the Youth Center or on the premises is prohibited.
8. Possession of devices normally recognized as deadly or dangerous weapons, such as knives, guns, firecrackers, etc., is prohibited.
9. Youth Center property and equipment is purchased with government funds and must be treated with care and respect to ensure damage does not occur. Those responsible for damage due to improper behavior will be held liable.
10. Food and drinks will be consumed in designated areas only.
11. Pets are not permitted on Youth Center premises or at sponsored events.
12. High standards of social conduct will be maintained. Theft, fighting, gambling, and profane language or obscene gestures are prohibited in or on Youth Center premises.
13. Participants are expected to be respectful of one another, Youth Center staff, and the staff is expected to be respectful of Youth Center participants.
14. Participants are solely responsible for the safekeeping of their property.
15. I pledge to be a Youth for Character. I will be worthy of trust. I will be respectful and responsible, doing what I must. I will always act with fairness. I will show that I care. I will be a good citizen, and always do my share.
