Child Development Centers & School-Age Center 2011 Information Paper



Parent Central Office: Located in the Lee Area Child Development Center, Bldg. 140, Parent Central provides centralized enrollment and waiting lists for all child, youth, and teen programs, resource/referral for childcare on and off post, teen baby-sitter training, extended hours care, special center openings and Kids on Site at approved sites other than the CDC when groups cannot be accommodated in the CDC. All patrons must register with Parent Central to utilize any CYSS program. Contact the Parent and Outreach Services Director at 938-3921 for more information. Full Day Care: The full day program located at the Stony Area Child Development Center, Bldg. 1207, includes center-based services that meet the needs of working parents requiring childcare services 5 through 11 hours per day for children ages 6 weeks to 5 years on a regularly scheduled basis. Fees are based on total Family income. The center's hours of operation are Monday through Friday, 6:00am - 5:30pm. For more information, please call the Stony Area CDC at 938-4798.

Hourly Care: This program includes center-based developmental childcare that meets the needs of parents requiring short term childcare on an intermittent basis. These spaces will not be filled by full day overflow or patrons requiring services on a regular basis. The combined usage of part-day preschool and hourly care may not exceed 24 hours per week. Fees for hourly care are \$4 per hour, per child. Stony Area CDC offers hourly care for ages 6 weeks to 5 years (not enrolled in kindergarten), Monday-Friday from 7:30am - 5:00pm. Hourly Care is also available for children ages 2-5 (not enrolled in kindergarten) at Lee Area CDC, Bldg. 140, Monday through Friday from 8:30am-5:30pm. For information on hourly care at Lee Area CDC, please call 938-0941/0942.

Part-Day PreSchool: This program held September through May is for children 3-5 years old and is based on the Creative Curriculum. The classroom is arranged in interest areas of literacy, math/science, art, blocks, dramatic play, manipulative toys and games. There is a good balance between child initiated play and teacher directed activities. The combined usage of part-day preschool and hourly care may not exceed 24 hours per week. Part-Day Preschool is available at the Lee Area CDC and classes are offered as follows:

2 Day- Tuesday & Thursday, 9am-12pm 3 Day- Monday, Wednesday & Friday, 9am-12pm 5 Day- Monday-Friday, 1-4pm

Family Child Care (FCC): FCC homes offer a full range of hourly, part-day, and full-day care for children best served within a small group or home setting. These homes are of particular value to sponsors whose hours exceed those of center-based programs. FCC providers are private contractors certified and monitored by CYSS. Because FCC providers are private contractors, they may develop some of their own policies/procedures which are contained in a written contract. Provider referrals are made through the Parent Central Office in Building 140, 938-4458/0939. Contact the Director's office at 938-0086, if you are interested in becoming a FCC provider.

School-Age Center (SAC): Before (6:00-8:15am) and afterschool (2:30-5:30pm) care is provided Monday- Friday for grades K-5 at Bldg. 693. Programs run throughout the academic year and on a full time basis during school vacations. Families interested in using SAC for before and/or afterschool or on a drop in/hourly care basis, are required to register prior to utilizing services. Please contact CYSS Parent Central at 938-4458/0939 to make a registration appointment. It is recommended that hourly reservations be made at least 24 hours prior to attending to ensure space availability. Patrons using hourly care receive four free hours per child/per month for SAC. Reservations for hourly care at SAC may be made by calling 938-8530.
